# Disabling SpamAssassin and Spams Filters

## A) Disabling SpamAssassin

1. Open your Internet Explorer (Mozilla Fire Fox, Safari, etc.)

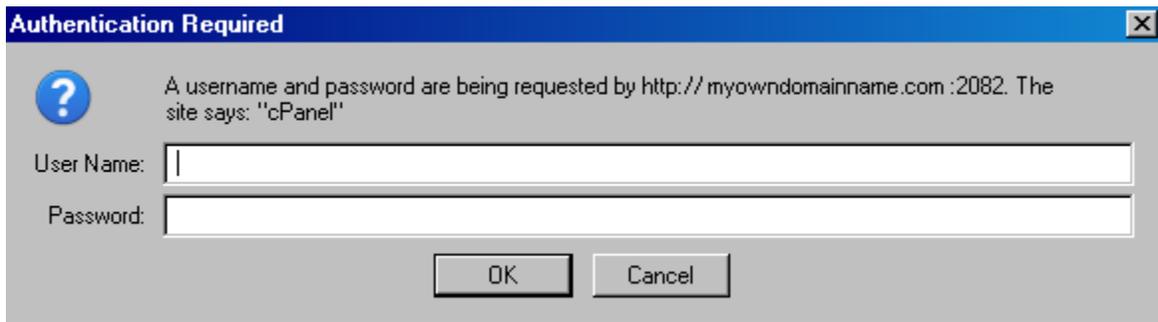

2. In the address bar, type in [www.<your domain name>/cpanel](http://www.<your domain name>/cpanel)  
Eg. [www.myowndomainname.com/webmail](http://www.myowndomainname.com/webmail)

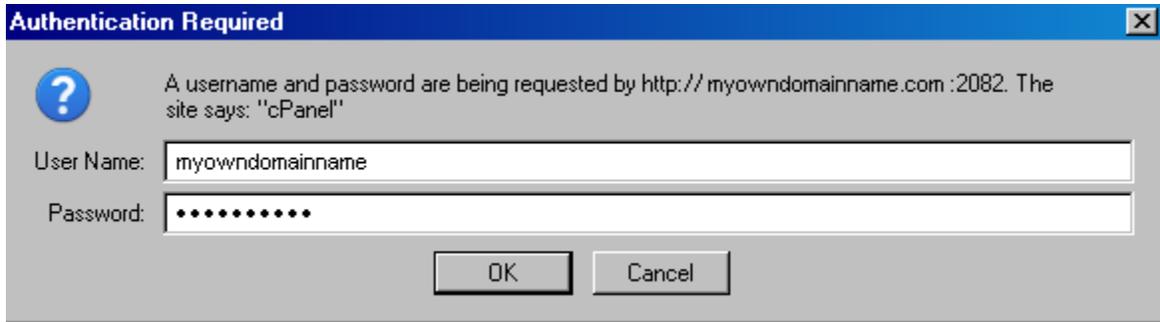


3. Follow after will be a pop up as shown below

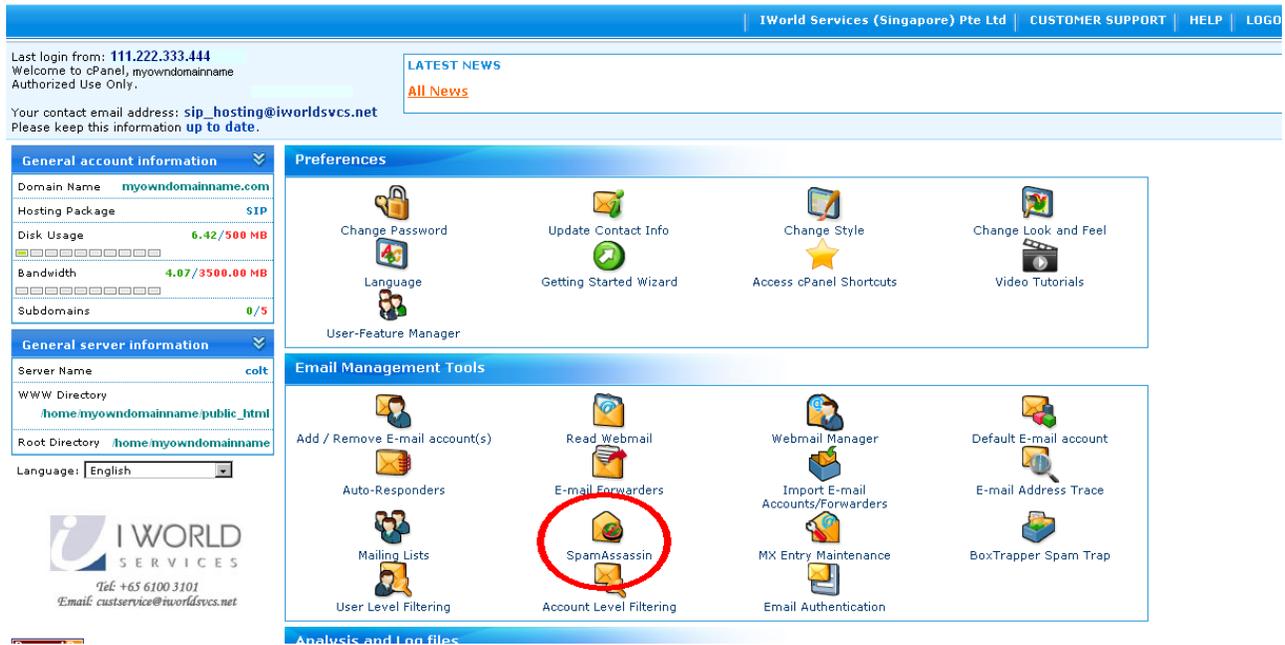


4. The means of the pop out window is to request your "User Name" and "Password". The username and password will be send to you by Iworld Hosting Team. Please key it in and click the "OK" button.

Eg. User Name : myowndomainname, Password : <default, unless you have changed it>



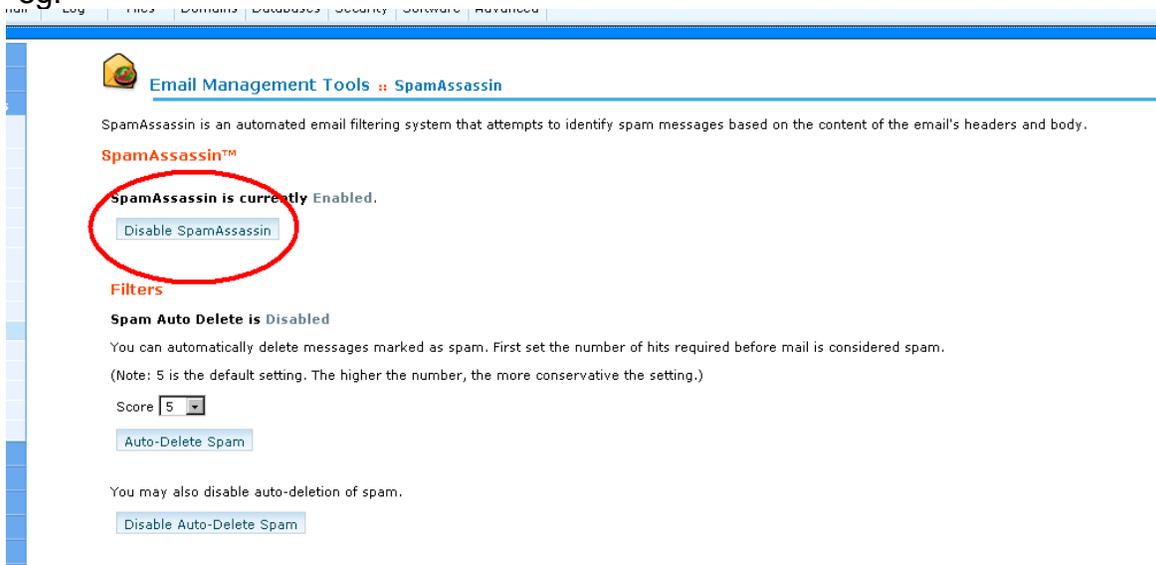
5. After which, the page will load into the Home Page of your web hosting Control Panel  
Eg.



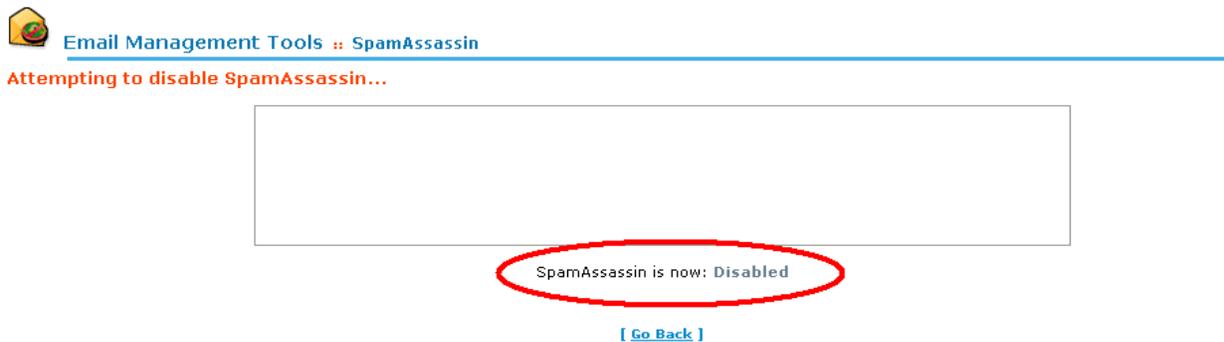
6. Firstly, click on the “SpamAssassin” icon under “Email Management Tools”.

7. Next, click on “Disable SpamAssassin”

8. The SpamAssassin is DISABLED.

9. Now, go back to the SpamAssassin page by clicking on the “ [ [Go Back](#) ] ”  
eg.



10. Next, click on the “Account Level Filtering” on the left hand side of the page.  
eg.

11. It will load into a page like below. After that then click on “Delete” beside the Spam Rules (filter). You need to delete each filter one at the time until left the last filter to delete it all away.

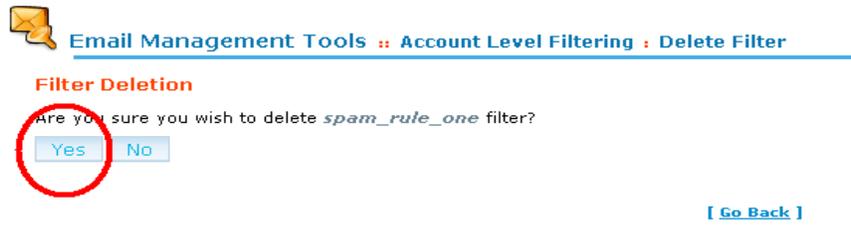

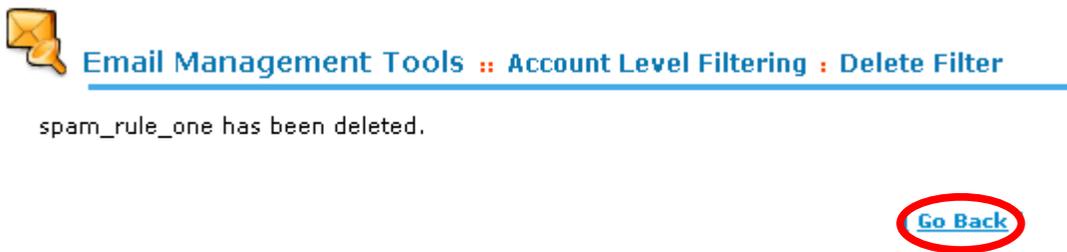

eg.

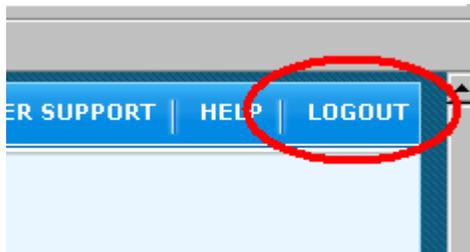


13. The result of the deleted rule (filter) will be shown like this, click go back. Repeat step 11 until all filter is removed.
